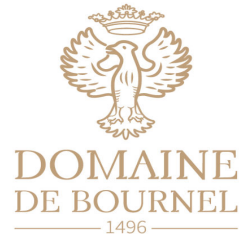


LOCAL RULES - GOLF DE BOURNEL



In addition to the permanent Local Rules from the French Federation (Hard Card).

Rule type E-3:

A ball resting in the general area cut to fairway height or less may, without penalty, preferably after being marked, be lifted, cleaned, and placed within one scorecard length (15 cm) from its original position, no closer to the hole, and still in the general area.

A ball may only be placed once.

R16.1

– IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS: - Paved or gravelled paths

Hole 7: Rule type E-1.1:

Dropping Zone (additional option) – to be removed for official competitions.

- For any ball in one of the three pond areas: dropping zone on the high right edge of the green

.

Note: This local rule is not valid during official competitions where the penalty area must be played as part of the challenge.

Hole 18: Rule type E-1.2

: Dropping Zone (additional option)

- For any ball resting on the portion of road marked with blue/white lines, and its ditches, below the green.

R6.4b(2):

Ready ? => Play – in a safe and responsible manner.

- The sheet piling on hole 7 is part of the course and within the penalty area.

- The penalty area to the right of hole 17 tee extends infinitely beyond the creek.

- Tee-off on hole 18 has priority over play on hole 17.

Penalty for breach of a local rule: General penalty

That is 2 strokes in strokeplay, loss of the hole in matchplay
